## FAUmentoring ARIADNE rewi

The **ARIADNE rewi** mentoring program provides individual support to young female researchers with high potential at the Faculty of Business, Economics, and Law at FAU at the beginning of their academic careers. During the mentoring program, an experienced researcher (mentor) provides advice to a young female researcher (mentee) about the strategic and practical aspects of an academic career, introduces her to various networks and helps her to understand the workings and unwritten rules of academia.

## Networking program

The personal interaction between mentor and mentee is supplemented by a supporting program, which comprises an opening and closing ceremony, an introduction to mentoring as well as networking events. The latter offer participants the opportunity to exchange ideas and network together.

## Aim of the program

The aim of the program is to increase the proportion of women in higher academic qualification levels in law and business and economics.

## Mentees

The program is aimed at young female researchers who wish to pursue an academic career:

- habilitation candidates
- postdoctoral researchers and
- doctoral candidates at the Faculty of Business, Economics, and Law and
- female students at the final stage of their degree at the School of Law.

- have the opportunity to set up and expand their own networks
- gain valuable insights into the experiences of someone who has advanced professionally and has a successful academic career.
